

Ushers

Your role as an usher

Ushers are tasked with helping people feel welcomed by assisting with seating church attenders, answering service questions, and executing the taking up of tithe/offering. Ushers also serve as a first-line of security.

Expectations

1. Doing Ministry: 1-2 hours weekly; serve at least 1x/monthly
2. Training/Community Building: when scheduled, 1-2 hours/month
3. Length of Service: six months

Responsibilities/Duties

- Arrive 30 minutes before the service to attend pre-service huddle and be in position 20 minutes before the service starts
- Stay near front doors for first 10-15 minutes of service and assist church attenders in finding seats
- Place communion elements prior to service (on communion Sundays) and collect tithe/offering during service

Next Steps...

- Assist a veteran team member for 1 Sunday
- If this is a good ministry fit, you'll be asked to serve at least 1 Sun a month with a 1-month trial-run. Supplemental training will be given.
