Your role working with middle or high-schoolers

Youth workers help raise up the next generation in several ways: providing rides, teaching a class, playing games, giving prayer or advice, etc. Each of these simple opportunities can make an eternal impact in the lives of Hawaii's young people AND their families. **Because of the nature of this position, a cleared background check is required.*

Expectations

1. Doing Ministry: 1-2 hours during the week at G2 and/or 1-2 hours on Sunday morning
2. Training/Community Building: when scheduled, 1-2 hours/month
3. Length of Service: 1 year

Responsibilities/Duties

- Specific duties will be determined based on team member's preference, skillset, and availability but may include;
 - Giving rides for church service or youth events
 - Providing prayer for youth and their family
 - Engage in planning events
 - Facilitating games alongside youth team
 - Leading a lesson or class for G2 or Sunday service
